

Internet Safety ...Points for Parents to consider

It is important to promote Online Safety in the home and to monitor your child's internet use.

- 1. Take an interest in what your children are doing online. Discuss what they see online and what they are doing.
- 2. Monitor on-line time and be aware of excessive hours spent on the internet.
- 3. Advise children to take care and to use the internet in a sensible and responsible manner. Know the SMART tips.
- 4. Discuss the fact that there are websites which are unsuitable.
- 5. Discuss how children can respond to unsuitable material and requests.
- 6. Tell children to never give out personal information on the internet.
- 7. Remind children that people on line may not be who they say they are.
- 8. Be Vigilant. Ensure that children do not arrange to meet someone they have met online.
- 9. Be aware that children may be using the internet in places other than in their own home or at school.
